- **as mad as a hatter:** crazy
- **barrel of laughs:** always joking
- **class act:** exceptional in what he/she does
- **cry baby:** very emotional and cries too easily.
- **daft as a bush:** very stupid
- **dumb as a rock:** with no common sense
- **hard as nails:** really tough
- **just off the boat:** naïve
- **plane Jane:** woman who's not attractive
- **pleased as punch:** very satisfied with something
- **sharp as a tack:** very clever
- **two faced:** someone who tells you something but when you are not around he/she will say something different
- **yes-man:** someone who always agrees with people
- **rest on your laurels:** someone who relies on the past achievements rather than trying to achieve things now.
