

Future forms: going to / Will

Future form : Going to

Subject + to be + going to + infinitive (complements)

e.g: The sky is dark, it's going to rain!

- We use the “going to” form for plans when we can see future in the present- a future situation in starting or on the way.

Future form: Will / Won't

Subject+ will+ infinitive

Subject + won't + infinitive

e.g. I will buy a CD.

I won't buy a CD

- We use “will/won't” for spontaneous statements (promises, offers and decisions) and predictions.
